











# YOUR PROGRESS ATT EEC
















This course helps students to build on their knowledge and command of English. It aims to improve the students in all areas of the English language: vocabulary, grammar, reading, writing, listening and speaking.






This course is offered at two levels: Foundation & Advanced.














### **OUR LOCATION**













































































































































